

Audubon members, our first field trip of the season will be Tuesday, November 24th. Our destination is Magness Lake near Heber Springs. Every November a large flock of Trumpeter Swans migrate to Magness (and a few other nearby lakes) to spend the winter. Occasionally, a Tundra Swan joins the group.

This is an easy trip with no hiking required. We will meet at the parking area just outside of the East Gate at 8:00. The drive is about 2 hours. We'll stop for lunch before heading back. We should be back in the Village before 4. Bring water/snacks and your camera. The parking areas can get a little muddy if there has been rain.
